Established in 2003, the Thornton W. Mitchell Service Award seeks to recognize an individual who has demonstrated outstanding service to the archival profession in the state of North Carolina by

- promoting public awareness, appreciation, or support of cultural heritage institutions, or
- · preserving historical and cultural resources, or
- providing leadership in archival organizations or associations, or
- teaching, training, or mentoring new members of the archival profession.

The nominee does not have to be a member of The Society of North Carolina Archivists, but must have at least 5 years of service in the archival profession. The nominee may not be a member of the current SNCA Executive Board or Development Committee. The recipient of the Thornton W. Mitchell Service Award will be determined by the Society's Development Committee and announced at the Society's Spring meeting in conjunction with the Gene J. Williams Award.
